Product description, installation and maintenance Zellige tiles

Zellige (zilij) is handmade clay tiles that is glazed and kiln fired, each tile is unique in both shape and colour. The tiles are hand-molded and hand-cut which can cause splinters to appear from the glaze. Zellige tiles are uneven in structure and thickness, no two Zellige tiles are exactly the same.

When the tiles are put in place and grouted will each tiles imperfection provide the final result with a unique and beautiful appearance.

Zellige tiles are not perfect and never will be. These tiles are suitable for you whom love and appreciate the natural beauty that these tiles offer.

Installation

1. Since the tiles are hand-made and therefore subject to color variations we recommend that you mix the tiles randomly from different boxes when laying them out in order to balance color and tone variation to achieve the best overall aesthetic appearance
2. Soak each tile in clean water for 1-2 minutes
3. Make sure that the surface where the tiles are to be installed on, is solid, dust and dirt free.
4. Apply adhesives on the surface that should be tiled and another coat of adhesives on each tile
5. Install one tile at the time
6. Since the tiles are uneven, wedge spacers might be needed
7. Snap with tile cutter in order to cut the tiles. Slice with a diamond blade if preferred
8. Grout a few tiles at the time
9. Please make sure to remove excess grout

Advice! If you wish remedy the splinters that are a natural part of Zellige tiles we recommend you to use a grout which matches the glaze of the tiles.

Maintenance

Clean your Zellige tiles with a natural floor soap.
